**Transplant Journey:** While Julia's mother, Vanessa, was pregnant the doctors noticed the baby was not getting any amniotic fluid. Julia was delivered at 36 weeks, weighing 6 lbs., and diagnosed with Autosomal Recessive Polycystic Kidney Disease (ARPKD). ARPKD causes enlarged kidneys and liver fibrosis, but Julia remained strong and has grown into a beautiful 11-year-old. In December 2019, she began dialysis and almost a year later, had a double nephrectomy continuing dialysis treatment three time a day. On August 15, Julia celebrated the gift of life receiving a new liver and kidney!
